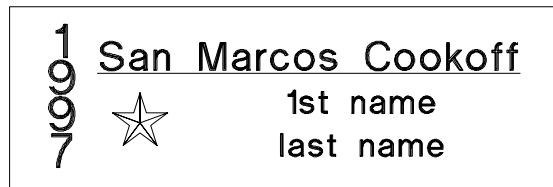




## Project #134

Re:Xenotech Projects

### Example Variable Data Entry using Method #3




1. Create a job with an individual plate size of 1x3 and a multiple plate size of 3x6 with logo (e.g., a star) and "header" line (San Marcos Cookoff), Vertical text (1997) and "placeholders" for the 1st & lastname.

Tip: 1st & lastname have left margins of 1" and right margins of .15" and are *Center Justified* to offset toward the right of the plate but be centered on each other.

2. **Xenotech | Notepad** from the Menu Bar to call up the Windows™ Notepad.

3. In the notepad, type in the following lines pressing  after each line.

Niel  
Johnson  
Rob  
Turney  
Sue  
Rhiehnhart  
Joe  
Vandess  
Terri  
LeRonn  
Ronnie  
Berwer

4. Now with the mouse below and to the right of all the text,  (that means press left button and drag) to the upper left selection all the names.

5. From the Notepad menu bar (not the Xenotech menu bar) **Edit | Copy** to copy all the names into the Windows™ clipboard.













6. **File | Exit** to exit Notepad.

7. Now back in the Xenotech layout, select the two lines representing "place holders" for the 1st & last names.

8. **Page | Full View** from the Xenotech menu bar to display the multiple plate.

9. **Edit | Paste** from the Xenotech menu bar to past the names into the "place holders."
